

In the English language Flight means both flying with an airplane or with a spaceship as well as running away - to Mars. / So, why should we flee to Mars?

Slide No. 3:



"Earth is slowly dying". This was once the headline of an essay by bio-chemistry professor Isaac **Asimov**, 1971 in the German Mirror ((Spiegel)) Magazine. One year later, in 1972, the legendary Club of Rome report "The Limits to Growth" was published.

Asimov warned of the dangers of overpopulation growth, / environmental destruction, / and suggested re-locating at least some human beings to Mars before Earth is collapsing.

In addition to his scientific non-fiction books, Asimov also wrote science fiction novels. Elon Musk has been among his readers since a young age.

Slide No. 4:



On the left side: In **June 2003**, one of Germany's news magazines ran the headline "Race to Mars". What was meant by this / was a race between space probes and Mars rovers. NASA and ESA had long since / stopped thinking about a manned mission to Mars. For the nation-state experts, manned spaceflight to Mars had become distant science fiction. As told in the movie "Race to Mars".

But then something happened that the state authorities did not expect:

Slide No. 5:



A genius mind appeared on the space flight scene and founded the private company SpaceX in **June 2006**. His visions were re-usable, in-expensive spaceships. And a manned colony on Mars is his goal. Like Asimov suggested in his writings.

Our species, unfortunately only a small part of it deserves the honorary name of humanity, should establish offshoots on other planets, so that something good of us survives global catastrophes or a suicidal nuclear war.

Here we see Elon Musk with one of his Falcon rockets in the background taking off.

The Falcon rocket, a name which reminds of the ancient Egyptian god Horus, is based on the newly developed Merlin engine. The next generation engine Raptor flies partly on the basis of methane, which can be produced on Mars for return transport.


And SpaceX has also re-invented the old three-man Apollo space capsule:

Slide No. 6:



Here Elon stands in front of the new Dragon space capsule. It now has room for five cosmonauts, a future version also for seven **astro**nauts, even when the guys will not fly ad astra to the **stars** with this Dragon. A reason why I prefer to speak modestly about **cosmo**nauts. And this humble word is also closer to the necessary state of cosmic consciousness, the state of being a **cosmo**politan.

And we all should strive to become citizens of many worlds, a multi-planetary humanity, as Elon Musk promotes it, too.



Slide No. 7:

The Dragon space capsule is only a first beginning for the more advanced Starship to Mars Program. For the film adaptation of the Marvel figure of the super-entrepreneur Tony Stark with his flying iron suit as Iron man, his actor Robert Downey studied Elon Musk and his Tesla and SpaceX laboratories in several meetings and interviews.

This led to Elon Musk making a guest appearance on Iron man 2, where he spoke en passant with Tony Stark about Merlin propulsion and a new electronic spaceship drive.

And Iron man became Future man. Elon, like Greta Thunberg, has a motivating function for the collective consciousness of our species. He stands not only symbolically, but also real technologically for overcoming the schizoid border-line disease. This divides our species into 200 competing nation-state egos, Catholics and Protestants, Republicans and Democrats, US-Americans, Russians and Chinese...

In the end, this fragmentation and waste of trillions of dollars in destructive weapons technology will lead to the self-extermination of homo sapiens. We must free ourselves from this anti-evolutionary impasse. A humanistic oriented colony on Mars can be an important first step in this direction.

For this step forward we need guides of a new human kind. Humans with nerves of steel, with ingenious engineering skills and a deep psycho-historical knowledge. And with a heart who beats for the future of humanity. In short: Homo humanus integralis cosmopoliticus.


In this sense, it is correct that Der Spiegel (the Mirror) referred to Elon Musk as an "Extraterrestrial" ("Der Ausserirdische") on one of its title covers. Seen on the left side of the slide above.

Musk is not only known as a genius, with an ingenious progression form of Asperger's autism, like Greta Thunberg. But with his degree in physics (focusing engineering sciences) and a second degree in technological business administration / as well as an almost photographic memory / and his talent as a programmer and inventor / who really wants to bring Supra-AI machines and humans to Mars, he seems indeed a bit extra-terrestrial.

Dag Hammarskjöld.

Years ago, I already had written the German standard biography about this other "Extraterrestian", which is available at the book shop in the bistro area of the Planetarium. Dag Hammarskjöld - Visionary for the Future of Hum (weltdemokratie.de)

The Nobel Peace Prize winner Dag was from 1954 until his assassination in 1961 UN Secretary-General. He prevented in 1955 the outbreak of a War between USA and China. He ignored in 1956 in the Suez Canal crisis the veto in the UN Security Council and invented the UN blue helmets peacekeepers / which were not provided for / in the UN Charter.

He was regarded by the media at the time as a kind of prime minister of an imaginary world

citizen government and said about his independence as a cosmopolitan between the Western and Eastern blocs: "Of course, I started from Sweden. But after I have reached my orbit / as UN Secretary-General above the inter-national struggle, / I no longer get too close / to any nation." End of citation.

You see, as a biographer and author, I am used to high-flyers and extra-terrestrials, especially since the biography of Hammarskjöld has many parallels to that of Musk. Not only that they are both loners who were mobbed in their childhood because of their fathers activities.

Dag was murdered on behalf of the owners of the mining company Union Minière du Haut-Katanga close to Lake Tanganyika where later on Errol Musk was co-owner of another mining company to which he took his son Elon for visit...

Dag and his JUNO team tried to create a real humanity organization. After Dag had failed due to the resistance of the psychopaths of his time, we now have a second chance / through Elon to **initiate an offshoot of a future humanity at least on Mars**.

Well, if SpaceX succeeds in keeping nationalists, bureaucrats and religious enthusiasts away from Mars. First of all, we need a humanity-programmed Supra AI on Mars. And then scientifically and humanitarian oriented survival artists,

a little bit with the heart of Howard Wolowitz as we can view in the next video clip:

Slide No. 13:

Let's look at what Elon Musk has achieved so far in a graphic of his corporations network. He started with ZIP-2 and with X.com later named PayPal, where he developed basic functions himself.

After selling these both companies profitable, he founded the three central companies: TESLA, Solar City and SpaceX.



Supplemented by the civil engineering enterprise "The Boring Company", by Open AI, by Neura-link and further companies that can be helpful for future space exploration.

Not included in this graphic are his Foundation and the Ad Astra School, a kind of scientific-technological private school for future space children. As fare as I know, they do a very good job there.

The following video clip from the TV series "Young Sheldon" shows a highly gifted 9year-old, as was Elon Musk, who, as a slightly autistic loner, teaches the NASA speaker better in school lessons about spaceflight science:

Elon also gave the *"adult"* world an early lesson in programming when he created a video game with BASIC as a barely 12-year-old. He sold Blastar for \$ 500 and the journal "PC and Office Technology" published the ingeniously simplified program code and praised the young genius.




In Blastar you have to destroy an alien space transporter, which has hydrogen bombs on board to destroy humanity. Well, Elon was on his way early on to save humanity.

Slide No. 16:

On the left, the cover of "**Stranger in a strange land**". Written 1961 by one of the authors Musk read (and liked) as a teenager: Robert A. Heinlein, an aeronautical engineer, naval officer and pioneer of hard facts science fiction with often social-critical depth. Elon, too, is a stranger in a strange land from an early age on.

A Stranger in the land of a world society, which in its insane "normality" and conformity was about to destroy itself. As Joseph Conrad once wrote: we are drifting into "The heart of Darkness". Elon grew up in South-Africa, a country that had fallen apart in apartheid - as an exceptionally gifted child who was hardly understood by the others.



The novel tells the story of Michael Smith, a human who comes to Earth after being born on Mars and raised after the death of his parents by Martians who live in the underground. He returns into a post-Third World War United States, where organized religions are again too politically powerful. As an heir to his parents, he is extremely rich. But more important, through his childhood and youth on Mars together with the PSI-gifted Martians, he has acquired / extraordinary mental powers. Michael starts a Martian-influenced "Church of All Worlds" to heal the insanity of Homo sapiens and to help the species to become one humanity. He is killed by a mob. But through his training on Mars, he can maintaining his quantum consciousness field (some might say his soul or his mind) after the death of his body. In Buddhism this is called the Tulku principle.


Michael has an older mentor on Earth named Jubal Harshaw. A similar figure is later found under the name S.R. Hadden in the cosmological novel "Contact" written by Carl Sagan.

The book "Stranger..." won the 1962 Hugo Award for Best Novel and became the first science fiction novel to enter The New York Times Book Review's best-seller list. In 2012, it was included in a Library of Congress exhibition of "Books That Shaped America".

The artificial Martian word "grok" invented by Heinlein made its way into the English language. "Grok" means "to drink holy water with someone in a desert world" as Mars is today and Earth is likely to become. And it means also "to be in meditation peacefully one with someone or something". The word became common among science fiction fans and hippies, and later among computer programmers and hackers. It, too, has entered the Oxford English Dictionary.


Another book by Heinlein is entitled "Podkayne, Citizen of Mars", published in 1963 and later read by Elon.



The book is a first-person narrative consisting of the diary of Podkayne Fries, a 15-year-old Earth girl living now on Mars with her parents and her specially gifted 11-year-old brother **Clark**. Because of the unscheduled birth of their three test-tube babies, in-vitro triplets like Elon and his first wife Justine Wilson got, Podkayne's parents cancelled their trip to Earth. Podkayne flies alone with her brother on a large spaceship to Earth. On the way, Clarke defuses an atomic bomb on board. This goes in the direction of the Blastar video game programmed by Elon. Podkayne ends up fighting terrorists who want to destroy the in-ter-dependency of Mars to Earth connection, partly as a result of her brother's carelessness. At the end / the genius but partly autistic Clark / shows human compassion / by regretting his inability to cry. / But becoming a true **citizen of Mars** would be *only* a first cosmopolitical beginning:

Slide No. 18:

Aeronautical engineer Heinlein published in 1957 the book "**Citizen of the Galaxy**". The novel begins with Thorby, a defiant orphan boy who was bought at a slave auction by a seemingly scrap collector and universally educated in his deep underground domicile.




After the murder of his foster father, who was fighting against a new kind of slavery (or apartheid) in the Galaxy, Thorby is adopted by a Free Traders ship clan who's travelling from planet to planet. Thorby, who is also technologically highly gifted, saves the spaceship Sisu and his new clan family by destroying a pirate ship. This, too, goes in the direction of the Blastar video game.

Thorby is at last identified as Thor Bradley Rudbek, the long-lost heir of the very powerful, Rudbek interstellar enterprises network. Thorby returns to the cosmic enterprise of his parents and launches a proxy contest to win the control over the industrial network again. Knowing that "a person can't run out on his responsibilities", he decided to fight the labour slave trade as the head of Rudbek Industries. As in many of Heinlein's books, the gifted principal character grows in wisdom and knowledge by learning quickly from experiences and using their special abilities to resolve consequently problems - those of their own and those of the world society.

Slide No. 19:

Heinlein also wrote books about the terraforming of Mars and the cosmo-political problems the Martian settlers will have with corrupt Earth bureaucrats.

"Red Planet" is a 1949 novel about two of the students at a boarding school on Mars, Jim and Frank. It was the first appearance of Heinlein's spiritual Elder Race of Mars.



Jim became friend of a furry creature with the size of a basketball. He mistakenly believes that Willis is some kind of an animal. On the trip to the boarding school, it turns out that Willis is the childhood form of a later highly intelligent Martian. Along the way, through Willis' mediation, the boys participate in the water brotherhood ritual of "growing together". So, they become "water friends" of the Martians, a kind of inter-species "blood brotherhood". (A kind of water ritual that we also find among the desert peoples on earth.)


The two earth bureaucrats, the new director of the boarding school Howe and the Earth-Administrator of the Martian colonies Beecher plan **not** to supply any longer the thermal protection domes for the colonists – and other negative measures.

With the help of Wills, who overhears a conversation between the two with his audiographic memory, the boys escape the now more military conducted boarding school. On the trip to their parents' far away outpost, the harmless-looking Martians reveal to them that there exist an ancient, hyper-fast deep-underground railway system (like Hyperloop).

In this way they reach the colonial outposts in time to warn them of the conspiracy of the earth bureaucrats. The Martians aid the Earthly settlers against the officials of the fascistoid

Earth governments. These guys are de-materialized or expelled from Mars. The transnational Mars settlers have to pass a kind of **Turing test** and then get a residence permit for Mars. A kind of humanistic **brain drain to Mars**.

Slide No. 20:



Similar conflicts figured 1950 in Ray Bradbury's "The **Martian Chronicles**". Events in the chronicle include the apocalyptic destruction of the Mars and Earth civilizations, both instigated by US nationalists and flu-sick emigrants.

After the last remaining wave of emigrants has reached Mars, the internationalistic world on Earth perishes in a global nuclear war.




Here I have summarized just a few ideas in short sentences that may have accumulated in

Elon Musk's consciousness and subconsciousness through intensive reading of such science & fiction books, which are a kind of quantum information or as it was called in ancient India: **Akasha Chronicles**. I may remind you of Elon's flashes of light and faint-like absences in childhood and adolescence. This is how the ancient yoga texts describe the Kundalini effects of an intense *satori*-contact with the universal quantum *ocean* field.


"US astronaut Bowman attempted to use brute force against HAL. I was cautious to use Ahimsa in my negotiations with HAL."



The before mentioned Isaac Asimov has next to his four basic laws programming's for good AI also written about organizing the re-building of human civilization after a global collapse.

In his Foundation novels, he describes the emergence of an official future science foundation of futurologists and psychological historians, the Psycho-historians, who advise the leaders of the world of states and try to influence the course of history through mass media events. Like the Club of Rome, they are not very successful in doing so.




But Asimov also designs a second, unofficial foundation of slightly psi-talented elite psycho-historians, who actively influence certain important people (history makers) at certain (Kairos) points in time. This is where Isaac, whom I was able to get to know personally, used the idea of the Office for Strategic Services (O.S.S.).

From June 1942 to September 1945 / the O.S.S. was the intelligence agency personally initiated by President Roosevelt / to gather important information, analyse world politics, and conduct psychological and journalistic warfare. On September 20, 1945, President Truman signed Executive Order No. 9621 ending the O.S.S. There were too many freethinkers and cosmopolitans among the OSS officers and analysts. They wanted a more manageable secret service. The CIA was formed.

Among the O.S.S. Staff were John Ford, Arthur Goldberg, Saul K. Padover, Arthur Schlesinger Jr., Ralph Bunche, Heinrich Wieschhoff and Andrew Cordier. At least the last three worked for the UN from 1945 and served under Dag Hammarskjöld in his inner circle. Wieschhoff, who fled Nazi Germany in 1936, died with Dag in a plane crash in Africa in September 1961. The film "Cloak and Dagger" (1946) directed by Fritz Lang staring Gary Cooper as a atomic scientist who's recruited to OSS to contact European scientists working on the German nuclear weapons program to bring them out of Nazi Europe.

Slide No. 27:

But back to the psycho-history of Asimov's foundation idea. There is actually a small social science discipline called psychohistory. Its best-known representatives were the psychiatrists and psychoanalysts Robert Jay Lifton and Erik Erikson.



Slide No. 28:

If you want to preserve / the seeds of a new beginning / away from the turmoil of a collapsing world society, you should do so / far enough away from the world wars.

It is a highly intelligent idea to **place a positive Supra AI on Mars**, as well as the genetic **code** of some outstanding humans, / maybe even some frozen female ova and male sperm. You don't need a large human settlement for this.

After a total collapse of the unfortunately in their majority rather nationalistic, greedy and religiously fanatical insane majority of earth population, one can then start from Mars after a while with the re-population of the partially devastated Earth.

A re-terraforming of the earth. With a then hopefully more reasonable human species and an **educational program for eco-logical world citizenship** - possibly under the supervision of a philanthropic supra-AI.

In my work as a high school history teacher, in addition to writing books and leading psychological seminars for adults, I sometimes used SF literature to increase the plasticity of my students' thoughts.

Quite a few Sci-fi writers have had a slightly pre-cognitive ability to forecasting upcoming events and developments.

Read, for example, **Fritz Leiber**'s deeply socio-psychological story "Sanity" in 1944, in which he predicted the coming in 1953 of such a UN Secretary General as Dag Hammarskjöld - and his elimination by the psychopaths in the power centers of governments and colonial industrial corporations.**

One of the best-known pioneers of futurological forecasting was **H.G. Wells**. I recommend his 1933 work "The Shape of Things to Come" He predicted, among other things, the atomic bomb, a super-ship with the name **Titan**ic and its sinking by an iceberg / many years before these things actually happened.

His four works "The Outline of History" (1920), "The Open Conspiracy" (1928), "Science of Life" (1929) and "Wealth and Happiness of Mankind" (1932) were all designed to popularize the idea of creating a (federal) world state. In his view, this was the only alternative to a return to barbarism and ultimate annihilation.


And not an earth / ruled by heavily armed and self-destructive fools.


Well, but before Elon saves the depressed Tony Stark Iron man in space with his advanced Falcon space ship. As we will see in the following video clip:





WORLD VIEW

STEPHAN MÖGLE-STADEL easily remembers when he refused induction into the German military. Within 24 hours of sending written notification of his decision, the Berlin Wall fell.

The divisive symbol's collapse – on Nov. 9, 1989 – dovetailed with the nationalistic barriers

that Mogle-Stadel has personally struggled to rise above. The 26-yearold journalist from Hamburg visited two St. Louis-area churches last weekend to give speeches sponsored by the World Federalist Association (WFA) of Greater St. Louis.

That organization endorses a global government under the auspices of the United Nations. The WFA's present international president is British actor Peter Ustinov, whom Mogle-Stadel met last summer at a convention in the Netherlands. Prominent American members of the WFA include former presidential candidate John Anderson and U.S. Sen. Harris Wofford of Pennsylvania, who recently defeated Attorney General Dick Thornburgh.

After choosing to oppose conscription, Mogle-Stadel joined the WFA in his effort to persuade the German government to recognize his claim of "world" citizenship. German law allows for conscientious objectors on religious grounds, but the idea of a citizen devoid of national identity placed Mogle-Stadel's draft board in a quandary.

As a military alternative, Mogle-Stadel traveled to Washington, D.C., in January, and is now serving in a WFA-United Nations internship. The German government initially declined to accept the U.N. work as a substitute for service in the armed forces, but it has since quietly dropped efforts to

prosecute the case. Mogle-Stadel suspects the German government may be concerned that publicity over his case could give other young Germans inspiration.

With Germany's turbulent history, its recent reunification and the changing map of Europe, Mogle-Stadel says

current events may be critical to future world peace. In his opinion, German citizens should "place themselves freely under the authority of the United Nations so that the military can be disarmed and military technology can be transferred to pollution control and Third World development."

Mogle-Stadel fears that as international tensions escalate over trade, and there is increased conflict over limited natural resources, nation-states will fall into "old ways" of resolving disputes — wars. "We can only survive together," says the German draft resister.

Mogle-Stadel's angst is not unwarranted. Even at his young age, the global citizen's *weltanschauung*, or worldview, has been shaped by World War II, he says. Since the reunification of Germany in 1990, neofascism has surfaced, and its proponents have become more vocal, according to Mogle-Stadel. The extreme rightwingers are especially prevalent in eastern Germany and Berlin because the region's economic hardships lend credence to the Nazi message.

Among Mogle-Stadel's strongest influences are 19th-century American essayist Henry David Thoreau, the author of "Civil Disobedience," and psychoanalyst Erich Fromm, who fled the Hitler regime for the United States in 1933.
